Please let us know if you would like to arrange an update from your child's keyworker; they are always available on a daily basis for a chat.

Please ensure that your child has a drink and a healthy lunch box that does not include sweets, chocolate or sugary/fizzy drinks and due to allergies within the nursery nuts or eggs.

Please will you ensure packed lunches and belongings are labelled with your child's name.
